In the programme of 2013 we were focusing on directing the citizens' attention to the values and benefits given by the EU, through sharing the opinion of each towns about the (previously not existing) rights and opportunities given by the EU.

Afternoon of 28th June2013.

All three twintowns introduced themselves with their specific cultural program.

The goal was the presentation of the cultural diversity, understanding and accepting the difference between each others culture and history. Besides the differences, discovering the similarities is also important: citizens share their passion, joy, interests and thoughts as well.

Through the presentations (6 took place: dance and music for each twintown) the citizens got to know each other's everyday life, which broadens and enhances their empathy.

Every program started with a short description to help the audience understanding the essence of the presentation, and ended in a joint part, where the idea of being together was realized.

Morning of 29th June

With the leading of a EU expert a lecture reading took place. The expert helped the citizens to understand the values, opportunities and rights in the EU. After deep understanding of the topic the participants exchanged their own experiences through a discussion.

Citizens shared their own private experiences and examples, which drives them to name the positive changes, and learn new ones. Participants became more complete and active EU citizens by understanding the well known but not used rights and opportunities.

Our goal was to give the citizens positive experiences through this, and when they start living like it, they pass on the new values to more other people, and even regenerate it through establishing new contacts and relationships.

Morning of 30th June



The Mayors presented their towns' economic, social, and behavioral programs, paid special attention to their good practice, and sharing the experiences of participating in EU programmes, while searching for common opportunities.

No doubt that the citizens of the three twintowns got only positive experiences throughout the meeting. All prejudices and negative aspects against each others country and culture vanished away when we managed to know each other. This is the most important yield of this eu programme.

Our primary target group were all citizens of the participant towns, not only the participating ones, but those remained at home as well (they will be informed by the participants and the communication tools), the participating politicians, municipality members, representatives.

Impacts:

- they will be able to recognize the changing in EU, will implement new opportunities in their own life, and will use the experiences
- the relationship between the citizens of different countries will strengthen. They will keep in touch, share their new experiences as well.
- the distance of hundreds of miles will shorten, may disappear. Citizens get to know such cultural values and thinking that they haven't ever known, which helps them look themselves and their opportunities from a new angle, new perspective. It will motivate them to try the new attitude which they learn from their twintown partner citizens to try it at home.
- future oportunities based on these: participants become more conscious, which will multiplicate its effect to the whole community, and will spread.

New economic, social and personal programs will take effect regarding to the twintown agreements. Twintowns will realize each other's advantages together, which will make cooperations more effective. They will start living their live more conscious, will look for new european opportunities, which will create more democratic, more open minded communities.

Sustainable cooperations

Tradition-keeper groups will remain in closer connection, the existing cooperations will become stronger. This will improve the citizens personal relationships, they will follow each other's life, and works, too.



The relationship between the leaders will become stronger. They will synchronize strategies and opportunities often (3-4 times a year).

To implement common projects together, discuss yearly: the result will be bilateral progression in the areas of culinary, agriculture, food processing, sales, etc., shared programmes, unique relationships for starting up new businesses.
